OSHA Standards

- Construction: 1926.1203(e)(2)(vi) - “The atmosphere within the space must be continuously monitored....”

General Industry: 1910.146(d)(5)(ii) - “Monitor the space as necessary to determine if acceptable entry conditions are being maintained...”

CS Fatality Facts

Atmospheric hazards are the leading cause of death in confined spaces.

Of the 1030 confined space fatalities between 2011 and 2018 over 60% were related to hazardous atmospheric conditions.
